He spoke regarding an application for a dental practice on Sicklerville Road and requested the Township to waive the requirement of re-inspection of the test pit at this particular site. He also spoke of a commercial project on Route 73. He urged the Governing Body to re-consider the fees. He further asked for an explanation of the Township’s definition of “municipal engineer” versus the “planning board engineer”.

COMMENTS BY OFFICIALS:

Mayor Metzner stated there are no provisions in the Ordinance for waivers. She further explained why the municipal engineer was assigned to witness the pit tests. Mayor Metzner also stated that monies not used for testing will be returned to the developer.

Mr. Hanson explained the amount of time it takes to test the pits.

Mayor Metzner reiterated the Township’s position on preventing problems with basins.

Mr. Gallagher stated he has corresponded with the municipal engineer with regard to handling waivers.

ADJOURNMENT:

A Motion was made by Committeeman LoSasso and seconded by Committeeman Flamini to adjourn the meeting at 9:26 pm. The motion carried.

The Municipal Clerk provided the closing prayer.
