PET LICENSING & LEASHING REQUIREMENTS

Pets must be registered with the Township annually. An application must complete with a copy of the current rabies vaccination certificate attached. For additional information, please contact the Municipal Clerk's Office by calling 609-567-0700 option "0".

A current license issued by any other municipality of this state shall be accepted by the Township of Winslow.

Dog Leashing

No person owning or having the control, custody or possession of a dog shall permit such dog to run at large within the Township unless dog is on a leash and in the custody of some person capable of controlling dog.

VOTING INFORMATION

The Municipal Clerk is the Administrator of Elections and forms are available to register to vote, change your address, change party affiliation and request vote by mail ballots.

The Clerk's Office also offer free notary service. Please call ahead to ensure someone is available the day you need assistance.

CONSTRUCTION

Construction Permits are required to construct, enlarge, repair, alter, renovate, demolish, reconstruct or change the use of a building or structure or to install equipment.

Before beginning any work, please contact the Construction Office to see if a permit is required.

All pools including soft sided and inflatable require a permit.

Dumpsters require a permit before placement.

PLANNING & ZONING

A zoning permit requires a copy of a recent survey showing proposed improvements, HOA approval, if applicable; and a \$30.00 fee for residential permits; \$50.00 fee for commercial permits.

Building a new home? Call the office to find out the specific regulations. A new dwelling requires a \$250.00 fee for grading inspections performed by the Township Engineer as well as the Zoning Permit fee.

The State of NJ no longer requires a survey before closing on properties; if you do not have a survey and plan to add an addition, replace fencing, install pools/decks—you will need a recent survey. The Township does not provide this service and you would need to hire a professional land surveyor.

Winslow Township has two areas: Pinelands and Non-pinelands. Each area is under different zoning regulations. For specific questions about what is permitted in your zone, please contact the Planning and Zoning Department, 609-567-0700 ext. 6.



Trash & Recycling General Guidelines

Winslow Township utilizes automated trash and recycling pickup through Waste Management. Place at curbside by 7am. All garbage/trash must be placed inside suitable bags and in the Winslow Township issued container with the lid closed. No material can be sticking out of the lid. No loose bags or additional containers will be picked up.

The containers must stay with the home and should be there when you move in. If either toter is missing, please contact the Public Works Department at (609) 567-0700 option "2" or email publicworks@winslowtownship.com

Place Townshipissued trash and recycling toters/carts 3 to 5 feet apart with the "grab" bar facing the street. Allow 5 feet between the toters and other objects such as mailboxes or vehicles.



Paper and Cardboard

Newspaper, white paper, magazines and cardboard should be placed in your Winslow Township issued recycle container and placed at curbside for collection on your normal collection day by 7am.

Do not put your paper recyclable in plastic bags.

Do not recycle: Waxed paper or waxed cardboard, plastic trash bags, and items that should be in your trash container.

If you have a large quantity of cardboard from moving, residents may bring broken down cardboard (no tape or packaging material, please) to the Public Works yard at the Municipal Complex for recycling during normal business hours, Monday-Friday 7am-3:30pm.

Batteries - Automotive and Household

Car batteries are recyclable and may be dropped off at the Public Works Office. Household batteries are not recyclable and may be put with your normal trash.

Trash & Recycling General Guidelines Continued



Tires

Car and bicycle tires may be put out for curbside collection, no more than four per bulk collection day. Please be sure to have the rim off the tire. If it is a business they must be disposed of by business owner at their cost.

Yard Waste

Yard waste, including grass, tree limbs and plants, etc. are collected as recyclable year-round. You may use recyclable brown yard waste bags or any general container marked yard waste.

Place at curbside for collection in open containers, paper bags or tied bundles, not exceeding 50 lbs. for any one item.

Branches should be cut in 4 ft. lengths and securely tied.

Place yard waste several feet away from trash and recyclable.

DO NOT mix trash or recyclable with yard waste. DO NOT use plastic bags.

Stickers for your yard waste cans are available at the Winslow Township Public Works office, located behind the Municipal Building or by calling 609-567-0700 option "2".

Paints

Latex paints and empty containers are not hazardous waste and should be disposed of in your regular trash. Collectors require that they be air dried with lids removed to ensure pick up by our waste hauler. We recommend using kitty litter or sand as a drying agent.

White Goods

White Goods consist of refrigerators (doors must be off), washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, swing sets, (concrete must be removed), lawn mowers, hot water heaters and all other metal items. White goods are usually scheduled to be picked up on Fridays. Please call the Dept. of Public Works, Monday - Thursday for an appointment at (609) 567-0700, select option 2 or schedule via the My Winslow app by clicking on "start request". Acceptable Commingled Recyclables

All aluminum cans, plastic containers and glass bottles are to be put together in the recycle container provided by the Township.

Aluminum food and beverage containers - Aluminum soda and beer cans, cat food cans, etc. Glass food and beverage containers - Flint (clear), Amber (brown), Emerald (green). Ferrous Cans - Soup, coffee cans, etc.

P.E.T. plastic containers with the symbol #1.

H.D.P.E. natural plastic containers with the symbol #2. H.D.P.E. pigmented plastic containers with the symbol #2 - detergent, shampoo and bleach bottles without caps. Plastic numbers 4, 5, and 7 are no longer being recycled

Non-Recyclable Items

1. NO Plastic Bags

Plastic bags are the WORST contaminant in the recycling bin. The bags tangle up in the machines at the recycling center. Some big-box stores take plastic bags for recycling.

2. NO Materials in Plastic Bags

Workers have to slow the conveyor belts to rip open bags that contain recyclables and then add the bag to the heap of bags bounds for the landfill. These inefficiencies waste time and money.

3. Shredded Paper

Shredded paper is too small to sort. These pieces fall through the cracks of the sorting machines, stick to the belts and end up all over the floor. Please avoid shred- ding when possible because it destroys the potential for recycling. Shredded material should only be placed in your trash toter.

4. NO Scrap Metal

Scrap metal items of any size should not go into your curbside bin. These items cause excessive damage to the recycling equipment.

5. NO Hazardous Waste

Hazardous waste such as non-latex paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, and pesticides can be taken during Camden County Hazardous Waste collection events throughout the year.

6. NO Diapers or Bio-Hazardous Waste

Syringes and needles, diapers, and other sanitary products are not recyclables.

7. NO Non-Recyclable Plastics

There are many plastics that are still not recyclable. Plastic lids, foam, and any other plastics not listed in our recycling guidelines are not recyclable because stable markets do not exist for these materials.

8. NO Caps/Lids

Metal lids can be removed and recycled loose in the bin. Plastic lids and caps from glass bottles and jars should be thrown away.

9. NO Liquids

When we use compact bottles for shipping, liquids drip, splatter, and explode all over the floor - creating a sticky, smelly mess on the sorting floor. Please completely empty and quickly rinse out all containers before recycling.

10. NO Ceramics or Non-Recyclable Glass

Ceramics, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, porcelain, and window glass should not go into the bin. Their different melting points and chemical compositions will ruin new glass bottles.

11. NO Frozen Food Containers

Paperboard boxes that were designed for freezer foods, such as frozen pizza, and entrees, have plastic polymer sprayed on them to protect against freezer burn. That same coating prevents the box from breaking up in the recycling process. These materials are not recyclable or compostable.

Department of Public Works Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How can I contact the Public Works Department?

Q. What holidays affect the trash collection schedule?

A. There are six holidays a year that may affect your trash collection schedule: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If your trash collection day is on one of these holidays or if the holiday is during the week and your trash follows the holiday during that week, your collection will be a day later. See our website home page for any changes that may arise at www.winslowtownship.com.

Q. When is bulk picked up?

A. Bulk is picked up once per month. Bulk items such as couches and furniture can be placed out "as is" for collection on your bulk day. Toilets need to be unbolted from the tank for pick up. Carpet needs to be cut into 4 foot length or less, rolled and tied into bundles less than 45 lbs. each. Mattresses and box springs will need to be covered or wrapped in plastic before being disposed. Mattress/Box spring bags can be found at big box stores for a small cost. The schedule is as follows:

1st Thursday of the month-For residential bulk trash normally picked up on Monday

2nd Thursday of the month-For residential bulk trash normally picked up on Tuesday

3rd Thursday of the month-For residential bulk trash normally picked up on Wednesday

4th Thursday of the month-For residential bulk trash normally picked up on Thursday and Friday.

If the Thursday for your collection date falls on a holiday, Waste Management will pick it up on Friday.

There are no bulk pick ups completed on the 5th Thursday of the month

* If a holiday that Waste Management is closed falls on Thursday of your bulk week, bulk will be picked up on that Friday.

Snow Removal

Our Public Works Department is working hard to make driving safer and easier in snowy weather. Depending on the duration and amount of snowfall, township trucks may plow your street several times. As snow rolls off our plows, it will accumulate in driveways. Please understand that this is unavoidable and it is the homeowner's responsibility to clear it. Here are some helpful hints to make "snow" business less frustrating:

Shovel snow to the right side of your driveway (facing the street) to minimize the amount of snow entering your driveway.

If possible, wait until the township trucks have made at least two passes on your street before clearing your driveway. Shovel and/or blow snow onto the curb, not into the street.

DO NOT PARK cars on the street from one hour after snow has continuously fallen until 12 hours after snow has stopped. This speeds the removal process and prevents cars from being plowed in.

To insure safety of pedestrians, residents must remove snow from sidewalks following a snow fall. Please remember that children are walking to school and bus stops are all over town.

In the event of deep snow, please shovel around your mailbox and fire hydrants near your house – for your safety and your neighbors'.

County-Maintained Roads

Not all roads in Winslow Township are maintained by the township. During bad weather, we often receive calls from our residents about the condition of roads whose maintenance is the responsibility of Camden County. We're happy to relay your concerns, but if you would like to reach the Camden County Highway Department directly, please call (856) 783-0043.

Route 30, Route 73 and Spring Garden Road are maintained by the State of New Jersey:

Leaf Collection

The 2024 Spring Leaf collection is listed below. Leaves MUST be out on the first day of your scheduled week pick up to guarantee collection. We are able to service each street once during the scheduled week. Leaves must be free of branches, twigs, trash, and acorns as they will clog the machine and we will not be able to collect them. Do not park vehicles on top of or close to the leaf piles on your street as this will prevent our vehicles and crew from collecting them.

PROCEDURES FOR A SEWER SERVICE PROBLEM

Occasionally a homeowner will experience a problem with their sewer service; i.e., lateral blocked, drain lines not draining or draining extremely slowly.

As the owner you are responsible for your sewer lateral from the house to the street. A backup may be internal, or it may be from the sewer main located in the street.

It is recommended to contact Winslow Township Utilities first before contacting a plumber by calling (609) 567-0700 Monday thru Friday 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.

Winslow Township Utilities will check the sewer lines in the street and will advise you if it is necessary to contact a plumber.

Please be aware, that once a resident contacts a plumber, the resident is responsible for all costs associated with the plumber fees, etc.

After hours, holidays, nights and weekends – residents may call the non-emergency police number at (609) 561-3300 and On-Call Personnel from the Utilities Department will be dispatched to investigate.

Payments for water/sewer (not including Camden County Municipal Utilities aka CCMUA portion) are done through the Tax Collections Office. Please see that section for details.

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Property Maintenance Regulations



Trash Toter (s) Placement at curb

No trash garbage or recyclable shall be placed at the point designated for collection at or near any street earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the day before the designated day for collection, and shall be removed from the point designated no later than 6:00 p.m. the day after the designated day for collection.

Grass Maintenance

No person, firm or corporation owning or occupying property within the Township of Winslow shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such to exceed a height of six (6) inches.

Snow/Ice

Whenever surface of any public sidewalk along a public street or highway in the township shall be found to be covered by ice or two (2) inches or more of snow, it shall be the responsibility of the abutting property owner or occupant to remove said ice or snow within twelve (12) hours of daylight after the same shall fall or be formed thereon.

House Numbers

The owner, occupant or lessee of each house, store or other building must display house/building numbers. Below are the specifications please ensuring all buildings are clearly marked so emergency personnel can locate each property:

- (1) In Arabic numerals.
- (2) A minimum height of three (3) inches.
- (3) Mounted in a secure fashion to the front wall or porch of the building to be clearly visible from the street.

Visibility of numbers on building which is set back. If said house or building has a setback location then the owner, occupant or lessee shall provide a post, rod, including a mailbox, with the number affixed thereon and visible from the street upon which the building fronts.

Water Restrictions

Mandatory restriction of the use of water for outside water (watering lawn and landscaping, washing cars or exterior cleaning). Even numbered addresses can water on even numbered days and odd numbered addresses can water on odd numbered days. Water usage is restricted to 5:00 am to 7:00 am and 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Outside water usage is prohibited on the 31st day of the month.

Assessor's Office Helpful Tips & Information

Doing work on your home?

Did you know, you may qualify for a Five-Year Residential Abatement? Here is what you should know:

- 1. Residential single-family properties fifteen (15) years of age or older.
- 2. Property owners will have 30 days from the date of completion to file the application with the Assessor's Office.
- 3. Up to \$25,000 of the Tax Assessor's full and true value of the improvement may be abated (exempt) from property taxes for 5 years, for those who take out proper project permits.
- 4. There is no application fee required for this program.
- 5. Applications are available from the Construction Office or the Assessor's Office when you apply for the permit.

Property Tax and Utility Collections Information for New Residents



Tax Bills are due quarterly:

February 1	August 1
May 1	November 1

There is a 10-day grace period however, if payment is received after the 10th day interest reverts back to the due date. Bills are due to Winslow Township at 125 South Route 73, Braddock, NJ 08037. Questions? Call (609)567-0700 ext 2090.

Tax bills are only mailed out once a year in late July. Tax/Utility bills will not be in your name until the Camden County Clerks office sends the Tax Assessor the recorded deed. That can take between 6-8 weeks. Please contact this office if you would like a copy of your bill. Taxes or assessments are valid whether or not the taxpayer receives a bill.

Utility: The Winslow Township Water/Sewer Bills are due quarterly: 2/28, 5/30, 8/30 and 11/30.

There is another sewer bill that comes from the Camden County Municipal Utilities Authorities.

PROPERTY TAX AND UTILITY COLLECTIONS PAYMENTS

We accept cash and checks. If paying with debit or credit there is fee of 2.95%. Payment can be made in person, over the phone (844-611-4022), or online. If paying on the phone, please contact the office to get a pin number.

Additionally, there is a drop box located in the Police Station lobby of the municipal building for check or money order payments only.

New for 2024:

We are excited to announce that residents have the opportunity to opt into Auto-Pay for online payments using your preferred method of payment. This feature is available for settling both your tax and utility balances. PLEASE NOTE: There are fees associated with paying your bill online. If you pay by ACH or e-check, there is a \$1.95 convenience fee.

The fee for debit and credit card payments will be approximately 2.95% of your total payment.

How it works...

- 1. Head to www.winslowtownship.com, under the Departments tab click on Tax Collections, click Pay Online, then click on New Users: Click Here to Register.
- 2. You must be registered in Account Enrollment.
- 3. Click on "Opt into Auto Pay" in your account and follow prompts.

Once enrolled:

- 1. Residents will receive an email at least one week prior to the payment being processed on XX/XXXXXXX. Email will contain a CONFIRMATION #.
- 2. On said date, the payment will be for the total current balance and will be deducted from your selected method of payment.
- 3. Based on timing, if a resident signed up after the schedule is defined, they may not be included in the first run directly after registering. It is the resident's responsibility to check your account balance online and personal statements to ensure the payment was successful.

Cancelling a scheduled payment:

- 1. The notice will go out a week in advance to allow the resident time to act and make any changes or cancellation if necessary for whatever reason.
- a. If you want to cancel autopay for a single time, you will need to forward via email the CONFIRMATION # send an email along with a statement saying you wish to cancel the upcoming autopay at least 2 days before it is scheduled to be processed: Emails should be sent to collections@winslowtownship.com
- b. To cancel autopay entirely, residents will have to opt out in their account enrollment.


