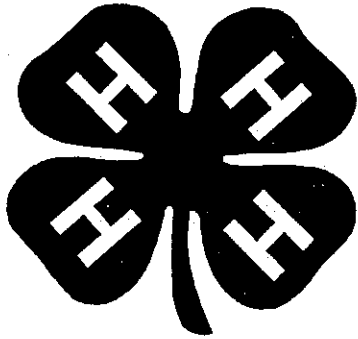

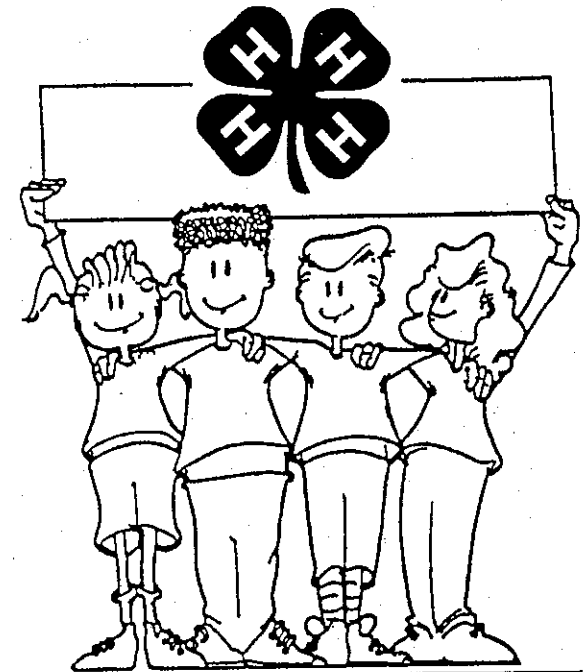

## **What is a 4-H Program?**

4-H is an informal, exciting and practical program for educational enrichment and youth development. In 4-H, you learn useful skills, have fun, solve problems, experience good citizenship and carry leadership roles and responsibilities.

## **What do you mean by 4-H?**

*The four H's stand for:*

**H**ead to clearer thinking,

**H**ear to greater loyalty,

**H**ands to larger service, and

**H**ealth to better living.

## **Isn't 4-H just for little kids and for those who live on farms?**

No! 4-H is for everyone! It doesn't matter who you are and where you live. There are many activities especially suitable for teenagers. For example, Teen Conference, trips, camps, competitive projects, dancing, interacting with other teens, visiting great places and more!



## **Why should I join 4-H? What are the benefits?**

## **Does it cost anything to join 4-H?**

There is no membership fee to join a 4-H club, most 4-H activities and events are free; however, each 4-H club may choose to collect a minimal fee for its own club activities.

## **What is a 4-H Club?**

A 4-H club is a group of teens or kids from different age groups led by an adult volunteer. The club members hold meetings, elect officers, and work on 4-H projects. Club meetings are conducted at the 4-H leader's home, at a member's residence, or at the Extension Office.

## **What happens at 4-H clubs?**

In a 4-H club, you will participate in many fun activities and projects. You learn by "doing" and have a great time too! You also receive training in leadership, interpersonal skills, public speaking and conducting meetings. Additionally, a 4-H club arranges for summer and winter camps, and offers you an opportunity for many social activities.

It's simple and easy! All you have to do is to call your County 4-H Agent. He/she will be happy and eager to guide you. You may even ask your friends to team up with you to join the 4-H!
